

Military Service Credit Guidelines

July 18, 2018

1. In accordance with the recommendations from the *American Council on Education (ACE), Guide to the Evaluation of Educational Experiences in the Armed Services*, credit for military experience is granted in compliance with CSU Executive Order 1036, Article 3 and CSU Channel Islands (CI) Senate Policy 10-08. Every effort will be made to award credit for specific university coursework, as opposed to free elective credit. Submit official transcripts/documentation to CSUCI, Registrar's Office, One University Drive, Camarillo, CA 93012.
 - a. Credit for military training courses and occupations will be awarded as follows:
 - i. Military training courses:
 1. Military Basic Training
 - a. Marine Corps students will receive 8 units; 3 units fulfilling General Education (GE) Area E and 5 units free electives.
 - b. All other branches will receive 4 units; 3 units fulfilling GE Area E and 1 unit free elective.
 2. All other courses will be awarded credit based on [ACE Military Guide](#) recommendations as illustrated in Exhibit A, page 2. Units will count as free electives.
 - ii. Credit for military occupations will be awarded free elective credit based on [ACE National Guide to College Credit for Workforce Training](#) recommendations as illustrated in Exhibit B, page 3.
 - iii. To receive credit, submit a copy of your DD 214, DD 295, or other official documents such as the Joint Services Transcript (JST) and the Community College of the Air Force (CCAF) transcript to Records and Registration.
 - b. Defense Language Institute Foreign Language Center (DLIFLC) credit will be awarded based on the [ACE National Guide to College Credit for Workforce Training](#).
 - i. Credit for Defense Language Proficiency Test (DLPT) and Advanced tests will be awarded as illustrated in Exhibit C, pages 4-8.
 1. A minimum of 3 lower division units are required to fulfill GE Area C2 and the University Language Requirement. Any remaining units will count as free electives.
 2. To receive credit, submit a copy of your official DLIFLC transcripts, JST, Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC) DLPT examinee results, or other official documents to Records and Registration.
 - ii. Credit for the Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) will be awarded as illustrated in Exhibit D, page 9.
 1. Data scores are converted into the DLPT score modality to determine credit granted.
 2. To receive credit, submit a copy of your DA 330 or other official documents to Records and Registration.
2. No more than 30 semester units of combined externally developed test credit (of which military credit is included) will be applied to the baccalaureate degree. Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, and basic military training are excluded from this limit. Credit is granted for baccalaureate/associate degree-level courses only. Graduate level work will be assessed by Graduate Programs. No credit will be granted for vocational-level courses.
3. Except as outlined above, formal approval is required for other GE Area and/or major course credit. The GE/Graduation Substitution Request form is available at https://www.csuci.edu/records-registration/rec_req_library.htm. For major course substitutions, contact the appropriate major advisor for assistance.

Learning Outcomes: Upon completion of the course, the student will be able to inspect and maintain aircraft systems, including hydraulic, pneumatic, landing gear, and flight control systems; demonstrate safety and aircraft recovery procedures; inspect, troubleshoot, repair and maintain airframe and engine systems; and demonstrate an understanding of the causes and effects of corrosion and corrosion control maintenance procedures.

Instruction: Correspondence course. General course topics include inspecting and maintaining aircraft flight controls; hydraulic systems; pneumatic systems; and landing gear systems.

Related Competencies: *Aircraft propulsion systems* topics include air induction system, engine electrical systems, engine lubrication systems, fuel systems, performance monitoring, and starting systems. *Aircraft systems fundamentals* topics include anti-skid systems, auxiliary power systems, emergency power systems, environmental systems, flight control systems, fuel level indicating systems, hydraulic power systems, and oxygen systems. *Aircraft systems inspection and troubleshooting* topics include aircraft inspection concepts, corrosion control, and engine borescope inspection.

Credit Recommendation: In the lower-division baccalaureate/associate degree category, 3 semester hours in aircraft propulsion systems, 3 in aircraft systems fundamentals, and 1 in aircraft systems inspection and troubleshooting. Note: AFIADL designates a minimum passing score at 65%. (1/10)(1/10).

Career Pattern

May have been selected for NEC 9519 from paygrades E-5 through E-9 in any rating. Will have completed all the requirements of the Navy Drug and Alcoholism Certification Program, including successful completion of the Navy Drug and Alcohol Counselor school, a minimum one-year internship as a Drug and Alcoholism Counselor Intern (NEC 9522), and successful completion of comprehensive oral and written certification examinations.

Description

Performs duties as a Drug and Alcohol Counselor. Duties include assessment and intake interviews, developing treatment plans, maintaining statistical data on patient's progress, preparing summary reports, conducting individual and group counseling, crisis intervention, aftercare planning, referral, conducting prevention, outreach, and other educational services related to alcohol and drug abuse, and providing counseling in other areas as prescribed by program sponsors. Counselors are charged with maintaining the highest code of standards as required by the Counselor Code of Ethics and maintaining a current knowledge about alcohol abuse, alcoholism and addiction. Provides routine direction and supervision, as directed, to NEC 9522 Interns.

Related Competencies

Case management topics include client advocacy, diagnosis, documentation (report writing), milieu service (resources across services), referral services, screening (intake), and treatment plan. **Law and ethics in substance abuse** topics include confidentiality, dangerous assessment to others, dangerous assessment to self, documentation (legal responsibility), federal ethics codes, HIPAA, national ethics codes, and reporting guidelines (mandated). **Management** topics include communications, counseling, interpersonal relations, leading, motivation, organizing, planning, problem solving, project management, and training coordination.

Recommendation

In the **lower-division baccalaureate/associate degree** category, **3** semester hours in case management, and **3** in law and ethics in substance abuse. In the **upper-division baccalaureate** degree category, **3** semester hours in management (11/09)(11/09).

Defense Language Proficiency Test (DLPT) Credit

Students will receive the following credit based on the recommendations of the **ACE National Guide to College Credit for Workforce Training** at <http://www2.acenet.edu/credit/?fuseaction=browse.getOrganizationDetail&FICE=190163>. The following examples demonstrate how to determine correct CI baccalaureate level credit. Example 1: Determining credit for one test

The *DLPT 5 Spanish Reading* test is completed with a score of 4 (DLI-0070). The student will be awarded 4 lower division (LD) units in GE C2 + 7 upper division (UD) free elective units + Language Requirement + International Perspectives (IP) Mission Pillar; a total of 11 units.

Example 2: Combining two tests to gain GE Area C2 credit

Two tests (same language) are combined to fulfill the required minimum of 3 LD units GE Area C2 and the Language Requirement.

- DLPT IV Italian Listening*; score of 0+ or 25-29[♦] (DLI-0216) = 1 LD unit in GE C2*; a total of 1 unit
- DLPT IV Italian Speaking*; score of 1 or 30-35[♦] (DLI-0221) = 2 LD units in GE C2*; a total of 2 units

[♦]**Note:** As of 4-1-02, test scores were converted to a single digit.

Example 3: Combining tests to gain credit for two GE Area C2 plus the Language Requirement

When two tests (may be different languages) are completed for 3-4 units each, one will fulfill GE C2 plus the Language Requirement. The other 3-4 units may be used to fulfill a second GE C2 requirement or if not needed as such, awarded as free electives.

- *DLPT 5 Spanish Reading* test with a score of 2 (DLI-0058) = 4 LD units in GE C2 + 4 UD free elective units + Language Requirement + International Perspectives (IP) Mission Pillar; a total of 8 units.
- *DLPT 5 Spanish Speaking* test with a score of 2 (DLI-0059) = 4 LD units in GE C2 + 4 UD free elective units + Language Requirement + International Perspectives (IP) Mission Pillar; a total of 8 units.

Credit earned for both tests:

- 4 LD units in GE C2 +
- 4 LD units in GE C2 or 4 free elective units) +
- 8 UD free elective units +
- Language Requirement +
- International Perspectives (IP) Mission Pillar;
- a total of 16 units.

Note: Students following GE patterns prior to 2018-2019 will receive GE Area C3a instead of GE Area C2 credit.
